

DWC is a performance-based event, and all entries must meet the published technical benchmark for their genre and category to be eligible to compete.

Eligibility Criteria

- Entry is open to any dancer, regardless of disability status, who can demonstrate the required technical ability for their category.
- Entrants must show the physical capability to execute the full movement vocabulary, timing, dynamics, and performance quality expected for their level.
- Judging standards and eligibility criteria will not be altered for any competitor.

Qualifying & Selection Process

- All entries must pass through a recognised qualifying process, live or via video.
- Adjudicators may mark an entry as "Not Eligible for Finals" if it does not meet the published technical benchmark, even if uncontested in its class.
- Head Adjudicators may review borderline cases for consistency across qualifiers.
- Decisions are final and based solely on technical and performance criteria requirements.

Equality and Safeguarding Statement

- The competition does not discriminate on the basis of disability, nationality, or background.
- All eligibility decisions are based exclusively on technical standards and the fairness and integrity of the competition.
- Organisers will make reasonable efforts to facilitate access without altering the technical standards required for participation.
